

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Why Use Sign Language?

• American Sign Language or ASL has six great benefits:

- 1. Because it's <u>Practical</u>: less fussing and more fun.
 - **a**. Young deaf children communicate non-verbally and they sometimes become frustrated, leading to tantrums and meltdowns. When Santa communicates with them on their level it often calms them down, encourages and reassures them that they are safe.
 - **b**. This makes for a much more positive and memorable experience for both the child and the parents.

2. It Is All Around Us

a. The deaf community is very large. Because silence is the language they speak, it can go unnoticed by the hearing. As Santa you must expect that you will eventually encounter a child who signs. By signing to a deaf child you are speaking to their heart in their language. And when you do, notice how their face brightens, and their eyes light up?

3. It's Easy to Learn

a. Sign language is easy to learn because it uses so many commonplace gestures.

4. It Allows Silence


a. This can be especially helpful with autistic children who are easily disturbed by loud noises.

5. It's Exceedingly Useful

6. It's Beautiful


a. Just watch a person use sign language. it looks like a work of art, like a graceful and beautiful ballet performance.



Cookie




(Right hand making "U" brushing down just below the lips to the top of the chin.)



"Rudolph the Red Nosed Reindeer!" (The "R" on nose followed by the Reindeer sign.)







Both hands formed into the letter "T" (Caution: Be sure to use both hands, because one hand means <u>Toilet</u>!)



(As putting stuffing inside.)




(Placing fingertips just under the shoulders, and moving the elbows in and out showing the animal breathing.)






(The Wings of an Angel as it unfolds and slowly rises up.)




(The same as Angel, except that move both hands as in gently flapping "Fairy Wings.")
